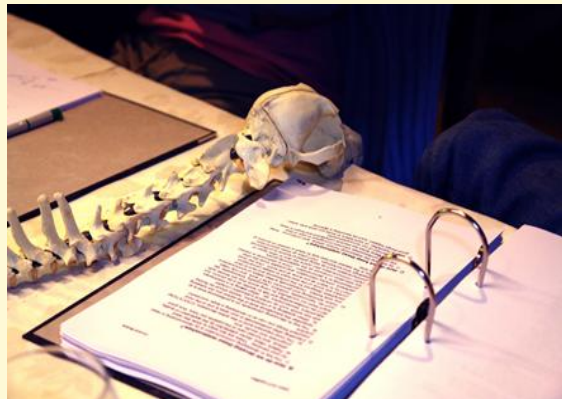


International Academy of Veterinary Chiropractic:

IAVC Canine Essentials of Veterinary Chiropractic Course 2025/26

The combined use of learning platform theory and in-person practical hands-on sessions form an ideal framework, developing the participant's knowledge and skills throughout the duration of the course.



Practical Session Dates to be announce soon:

Sacropelvic/Thoracolumbar; November 22nd – 23rd, 2025:

Comprehensive practical sessions with dogs including safety and handling of the animals, and an introduction to the quadruped chiropractic adjustment. The focus is on motion palpation, hand and body positioning, and treatment techniques of the quadruped sacropelvic and thoracolumbar region.



Cervical/ Extremities, February 28th – March 1st, 2026:

assessment and treatment techniques will be reviewed. Comprehensive practical sessions with dogs focusing on, hand and body positioning, the chiropractic adjustment and treatment techniques as well as motion palpation of the quadruped cervical spine and extremities.



Veterinary Chiropractic Integration, March 28th - 29th, 2026:

A review of all animal chiropractic assessment and treatment techniques. Comprehensive practical sessions with dogs and horses focusing on case management and treatment of the quadruped, as well as a final practical exam.
